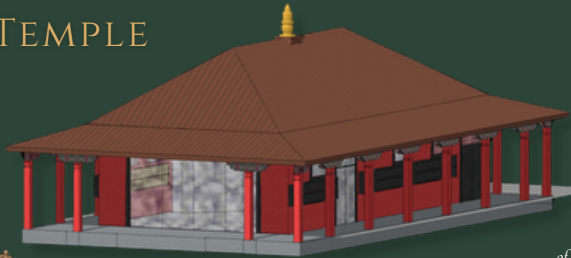



Tara's Pure Land will offer a modern kiln cremation with traditional Buddhist ritual and ceremonies, outside with the elements, to Lamas and lay practitioners alike. Holding Sustaining Sangha members, and their loved ones, as we accompany one another through life's final threshold with dignity, beauty, and meaning within the blessings of this sacred land.

Traditional Tibetan Cremation meets modernization with a custom built cremation kiln and ceremony presided over by respected Lamas in our tradition. With care and compassion, the cremation ceremonies will be offered to our Sangha Members, who can choose the level of services that fulfill your final wishes.

Volunteers, Sangha Members and your family and loved ones can attend and take part in the ceremony. Each cremation will include a traditional fire puja with offerings of sacred substances, followed by optional refreshments or lunch.

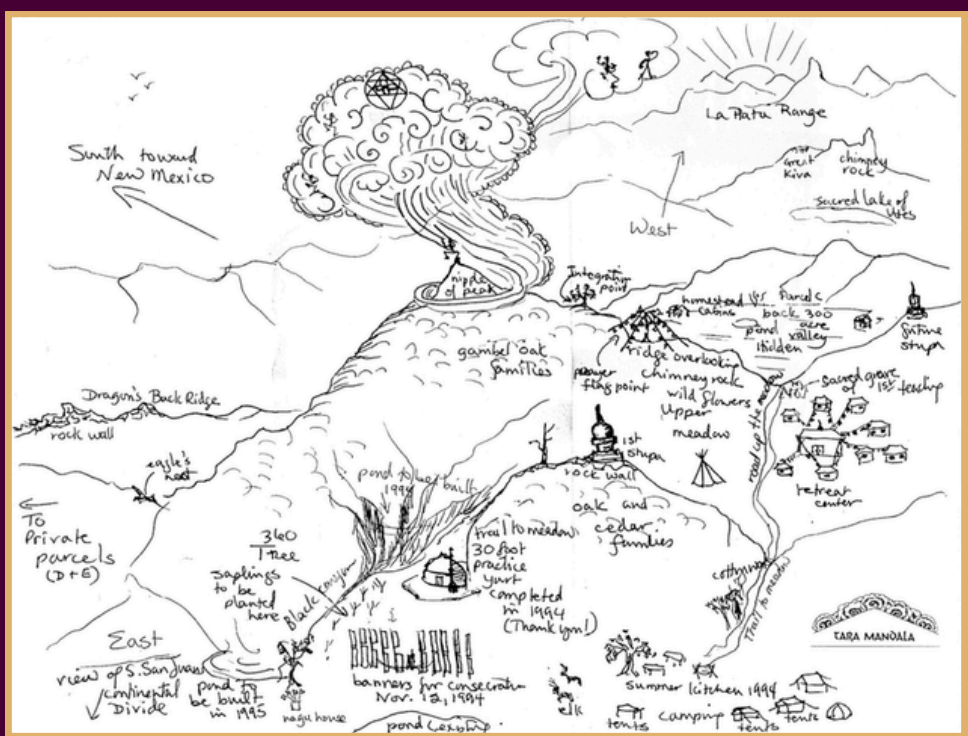
